Check out these examples of how your gift impacts 1 in 3 Blount Countians all year long!

**\$1**  
per pay period

Trains 4 adults to properly identify signs of child sexual abuse.

**\$3**

Provides food to 180 children, adults and seniors, ensuring instant relief from hunger.

**\$5**

Provides emergency assistance for 26 families to keep their utilities on in their homes.
