

United Way of Blount County is a nonprofit organization exempt from income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and provides supporting services and other assistance to public and private agencies and community organizations to meet the human service needs of the general public of Blount County. UNBC is a local autonomous organization governed by a local board of directors and operates under a charitable solicitation permit issued by the State of Tennessee. UNBC pays annual dues of 0.15% to United Ways of Tennessee and 1% to United Way Worldwide. Based on 3-year average, UNBC deducts 12.8% of the total amount pledged to UNBC and its community partners to cover fundraisin and administration costs. UNBC does not charge a fee for processing and distributing designated pledges, but budgets 5.5 to cover uncollectible pledges and systems on the amount that is actually collected. United Way do not provide goods or services in whole or partial consideration for any contributions made to United Way do
